Pool Rentals

\$4 per person – minimum rate per hour \$50
(Up to 30 people - \$2 for each additional person over 30 participants) Association rates available. Call Wellness Director at 336-3660.

- All groups are required to have a minimum adult to child ratio of 1:10 during group usage. Children 5 & under must be accompanied by an adult, in the water, at all times. A locker room attendant must be provided by the group using the facility for the beginning and end of swim period (one for girls locker room, one for boys locker room)

Gym Rentals (downtown)

\$25 first hour, \$20 each additional hour
\$60 ½ day rate (4 hours)
\$100 full day rate (8 hours)

- All groups are required to have a minimum adult to child ratio of 1:10 during group usage.

Gym Rentals (south) rent ½ of gym space

\$35 first hour, \$30 each additional hour
\$100 ½ day rate (4 hours)
\$175 full day rate (8 hours)

- All groups are required to have a minimum adult to child ratio of 1:10 during group usage.

Aerobics Studio/Front Lobby

\$25 per hour per group, up to 20 people

- All groups are required to have a minimum adult to child ratio of 1:10 during group usage.

Conference /Meeting Room

Non-profit/Private:

\$50 for ½ day (4 hours); \$100 for full day rate (8 hours)

Corporate:

\$75 for ½ day (4 hours); \$150 for full day (8 hours)

YWCA rental responsibilities, rules and regulations

Welcome to the YWCA! We hope your event is enjoyable and memorable. In order to provide you with the safest and most pleasant environment we must insist on the following responsibilities, rules, and regulations:

- A deposit of \$50 will need to be made upon booking and before we reserve the space. Deposit will be refunded upon return of the areas use. The area is to be reasonably cleaned and undamaged.
 - Place someone in charge if you must leave the facility.
 - End your event without disturbance.
 - Ensure all guests leave the facility premises immediately following your event.
 - Remove all equipment you brought to the facility within the hours stated on the rental agreement.
 - Accept responsibility for damage or loss of equipment.
 - Clean up: Remove all items from tables. Excessive spills must be cleared. All food refuse must be placed in garbage bags.
 - All cartons, boxes, packing crates, etc. must be removed to the YWCA dumpster.
 - All users will conduct themselves in a courteous and professional manner at all times and shall not in any way infringe on the rights and operation of any member or guest of the YWCA
 - Know and take responsibility for all of your guests.
 - User's vehicles shall be parked in designated parking/loading areas only.
- Pool information:
- All children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult, in or out of the water, at all times.
 - All swimmers must have a swimming suit. No cutoffs, t-shirts, leotards, jeans, etc.
 - The front lobby is a public area and we ask that you and your guests have either clothes or a cover up on. Shoes are required in the lobby at all times.
 - Food and beverages are not permitted in the pool area.
 - All children who are not toilet trained shall wear a swim diaper or tight fitting rubber pants.
 - We allow water wings and swimsuits with built in floats as long as the parent or legal guardian are actively supervising the child.
 - Age 13 and over are allowed to use the whirlpool. The whirlpool shall not exceed 16 people. Observe reasonable time limits (10 – 15 minutes); long exposure may result in illness or fainting.

The YWCA has a zero tolerance policy. All users will conduct themselves in a courteous and professional manner at all times and shall not in any way infringe on the rights and operation of any member or guest of the YWCA.

Management has the authority to implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or that supplement those listed. Updated 1/12
